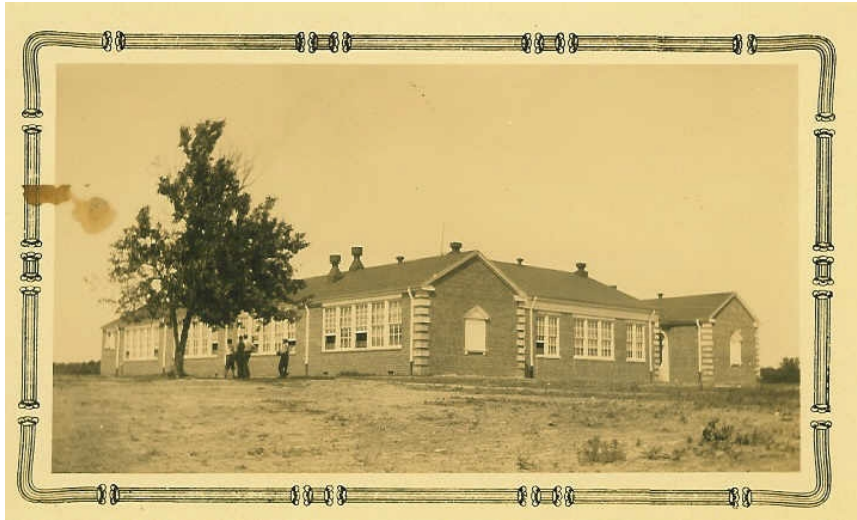

Our History

The *Montpelier Center for Arts & Education* was originally known as the *Montpelier School* (grades 1-11) and was built 1929, after the 1910 schoolhouse burned down. The *Montpelier School* was the last surviving public building in Hanover County constructed by funds raised solely from the local citizens used to provide an education for their children, during the Depression.

By 1988, the *Montpelier School* lay abandoned and scheduled for demolition by the County. Community leaders, upon learning of the planned demolition, organized the *Save Our School Foundation*. Funds were raised and restorations began. In 1991, the building was renamed the *Montpelier Center for Arts & Education* and was granted 501(c) 3 status.

Today, this highly visible landmark stands as a symbol of Virginia's tradition of caring, contributing, and providing opportunities. By supporting *the Montpelier Center for Arts & Education*, you are helping build on a foundation created by many volunteers. Currently, approximately 30,000 people in this region utilize the services provided by the *Montpelier Center for Arts & Education* and this number increases annually.
