The Montpelier Center for Arts and Education Frequently Asked Questions

Q - Is The Montpelier Center being torn down after the new library/rec center is constructed?

A - The Montpelier Center building is owned by a private nonprofit and not by Hanover County. It will not be torn down.

Q - Will The Montpelier Center programs be moved over to the new library/rec center?

A - The Montpelier Center is a private 501(c)3 nonprofit and is neither owned nor operated by Hanover County. The Center programs will stay in The Center building. The Library that rents space from The Center will move to the new building. The Center will then have even more space for events and activities.

Q - How is The Center funded?

A - Center funding comes from donations, rental income, and activity fees. The Center is not a government agency.

- A The preschool will stay right where it is.
- Q How old is the Montpelier Center?
- A The Montpelier Center was incorporated in 1991.
- Q Is the Montpelier Center Village Green part of Parks and Rec?

A - The Montpelier Village Green is a private garden maintained by The Montpelier Center for the pleasure and enrichment of the community.
