The **SOUTH-ATLANTIC JURIED EXHIBITION** is open to all professional artists who reside in Maryland, West Virginia, Virginia, Washington, D.C., North Carolina, South Carolina, Georgia, and Florida. Artists are invited to submit works completed within the last two years and not previously shown at The Montpelier Center. Show entry implies consent for The Montpelier Center to use images of any accepted artwork for marketing and publicity purposes.

ENTRY FEE: 3 entries per artist may be submitted for a non-refundable entry fee of \$30.00. All completed entries including entry form, fee and JPG images on Digital CDs or JPEG images sent by email to coa@montpeliercenter.org must arrive no later than Friday, March 20, 2015 to be considered. All digital image files must be saved as high resolution, 300dpi images in standard JPEG format no larger than 5MB with each JPEG titled as: titleofpiece_lastname.firstinitial.jpg (EX: Waterway_Jones.C.jpg). CDs should be labeled with artist's name and tested prior to submission. All CDs will become the property of The Montpelier Center. Notifications of the juror's selections will be posted at www.montpeliercenter.org on or about April 6, 2015.

<u>SALES</u>: The Montpelier Center will collect a commission of 30% on the sale of any artwork during or as a result of this exhibition. <u>All</u> artwork must be priced for sale and is to remain on display for the entire exhibition.

CONDITIONS: Works must be original: no reproductions or giclee prints. Although the beauty and expression of the nude figure is part of both traditional and contemporary art establishments, this genre is not part of this exhibit. The Montpelier Center reserves the right to exclude artwork that is deemed not to be suitable for viewing by all audiences. This exhibit is reserved for 2-D art, including paintings, collage and hand-altered original photographs (no Photoshop/computer generated images). Untouched photography entries are NOT included.

PRESENTATION: Works must be quality framed or gallery wrapped canvas with painted edges and wired for hanging (**no clips or sawtooth hangers**). Works cannot exceed 60" in height or width, weigh more than 50 lbs., or have wet medium. Title, medium, size, price and artist's name must be noted on the back of each piece.

<u>DELIVERY/PICKUP</u>: Hand delivery on Monday, April 20th, 2015. A representative of The Montpelier Center will be onsite to receive artwork from 10am to 4pm. Artwork should be delivered to The Montpelier Center for Arts & Education, 17205 Mountain Road, Montpelier, VA. See www.montpeliercenter.org for directions. Exhibited artwork must be picked up at The Montpelier Center on Tuesday, June 30th, 10am – 4pm.

LIABILITY & AGREEMENT: Although every reasonable precaution is taken to protect and secure artwork in its exhibitions, The Montpelier Center, the CoA committee and the Juror are not responsible for any loss or damage occurring to the art from the delivery date to the pickup date after the close of the exhibition. It is suggested that artists wishing additional protection should insure their works independently. Submission of a work to this exhibition shall constitute an agreement to comply with all conditions set forth in this prospectus.
