While you eat, enjoy a diverse selection of craft vendors, seasonal drinks, and incredible live music throughout the festival!



This class is designed for participants who wish to build on basic drawing and color mixing skills. Students will plan and create a painting of their choosing which could be a Master copy or an original image. We will discuss composition, value, edges, light and shadow and work toward developing our artist's "eye". Students may work in oils or acrylics and will furnish their own supplies. Participants should come with supplies ready to paint and are encouraged to explore in advance images they wish to use as reference. Teacher will assist as needed.





Are you often disappointed by the results of your photographs? The photos may be too dark or too light; the colors may look weird; or the compositions are just not what they saw in their mind's eye. The reason is that no camera is designed to automatically record what the eye sees. It needs help. To get the most out of this workshop students should have a digital camera that is capable of manual exposure settings. Cell phones do not have this capability but most pocket cameras do as well as any DSLR or Mirrorless camera.





#### Tuesday, October 11th @ 7:00 pm


