The **SOUTH-ATLANTIC JURIED EXHIBITION** is open to all professional artists who reside in Maryland, West Virginia, Virginia, Washington DC, North Carolina, South Carolina, Georgia, and Florida. Artists are invited to submit up to three works completed within the last two years and not previously shown at The Montpelier Center. All artwork must be for sale as art sales will be encouraged. Show entry implies consent for The Montpelier Center to use any accepted artwork for marketing and publicity activities.

Each artist may enter up to three paintings. **JPG images on Digital CDs or sent by Email to coa@montpeliercenter.org must arrive no later than Friday, April 7th to be considered.** Images must be saved as high resolution, 300dpi, images, each jpg image titled as: titleofpiece_lastname.firstInitial.jpg. (no symbols i.e. &). All CDs will become the property of The Montpelier Center. **DEADLINE FOR ENTRY: APRIL 7, 2014.**

RULES

Sales: All Entries must be priced "For Sale." A commission of 30% will be retained by The Montpelier Center. Sales will be promoted.

Liability & Agreement: Although the greatest care will be taken by The Montpelier Center, the Committee and Juror, liability for any loss or damage will not be assumed. The Center carries a minimal policy for theft and damage while on site. It is suggested that artists wishing additional protection, insure their works independently. Submission of a work to this exhibition shall constitute an agreement to comply with all conditions set forth in this prospectus. Permission to reproduce entries is granted unless otherwise noted.

Framing: Works must be framed, stripped or wrap-around canvas and ready to hang with wire and either screw eyes or D-rings. Sawtooth-type hangers will not be accepted. Works cannot exceed 60" in height or width, weigh more than 50 lbs, or have wet medium. **Title, price, and artist name, must be attached to the back of each piece.**

Limitations: Works must be original: **No reproductions nor giclee prints.** Although the beauty and expression of the nude figure is part of both the traditional and contemporary art establishments, this genre is not part of this exhibit. This exhibit is for 2-D art, including paintings, collage and hand-altered original photographs (no Photoshop/computer generated). Untouched photography entries are NOT included.

Delivery: *Hand Delivery on April 28th. Someone will be on site to receive paintings from 9am to 1pm and 6 to 8pm:* Paintings should be delivered to: The Montpelier Center for Arts & Education, 17205 Mountain Road, Montpelier, VA at the intersection of Route 715 (Clazemont Road) and Route 33, (Mountain Road). See www.montpeliercenter.org for directions.

Shipped Paintings must arrive no later than April 28th. All shipments must be prepaid or they will not be accepted. Return prepaid shipping labels, UPS or FedEx only, must be attached to the back of all shipments. Crate lids must be fastened with a screw or bolt. Improper crating may result in damage and will be returned unopened. Nailed crates will not be accepted. Commercial shipping boxes may be used.
